






- 1) Remove all packaging from the unit.
- 2) Place on a flat stable surface.
- 3) Turn the unit upside down.
- 4) Rotate the base cover in the direction of arrows to remove.
- 5) Remove the filter, and then remove filter from packaging.
- 6) Replace the filter into the unit.
- 7) Replace the base cover, turning to lock position.
- 8) Place the unit upright on a flat stable surface.
- 9) Connect the supplied power cable to your power outlet

Start/Stop function:

- Lightly press the Power button to turn on the unit.
- Lightly press the button again to turn the unit off.

Vita-Ion:

- Lightly press the Vita-Ion button to turn on the anion generator.
- Lightly press the Vita-Ion button again to turn off the anion generator.

UV Lamp:

- Lightly press the UV button to turn on the UV Air sterilisation function.
- Lightly press the UV button again to turn the function off.

Turbo function:

- Lightly press the Turbo button to turn on the turbo function.
- Lightly press the Turbo button again to turn this function off.

Caring for your Air Purifier

Filter Care and Replacement

Every 2-3 weeks remove the display panel and use a soft brush to gently brush the front of the filter to remove any larger particulates that have been captured.

Replacing Air Purifier Filter

The filter should be changed approximately every 6 months to maintain the effectiveness.

Only use the filters supplied or provided by **Breathing Better NZ** in your Air Purifier.

Cleaning your Air Purifier

- Turn off the unit and unplug the power cord.
- Clean the outside of the unit with a soft dry cloth.
- Use a soft brush to clean the air intake and outlet

Troubleshooting

| Abnormal noise from unit | Ensure all packaging is removed and check for damage to the unit Ensure the air inlet and outlet is not blocked by anything, and dean it if needed. While the negative ion function is on, "fizz" sound is normal. | |
